

COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) Response

## National Update – June 1, 2020

We remain firmly focused on promoting the safety and well-being of residents and team members through a number of expansive infection control measures that are in place amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. These continue to include restricting all non-essential visitors, daily temperature checks and symptom screenings of all residents and team members and more.

In addition to our infection control efforts, we continue to work closely and proactively with state and local health departments on our COVID-19 testing approach for residents and team members. We will share more information on expanded testing as it becomes available.

While we remain vigilant in our response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are also looking for new ways to re-introduce more variety into residents' daily routines and find opportunities for them to safely spend more time outside of their suites as we know it is important for their social, emotional and physical well-being. Things we're exploring include slowly and carefully introducing socially distant small group programming and limited out-of-suite dining. We will continue to closely follow the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other health and government agencies as we implement any such initiatives. Per that guidance, our policy of restricting all but medically necessary visitors will remain in place in all of our communities for the time being.

We have also put a number of new protocols in place that will allow us to cautiously welcome new residents that may benefit from our personalized care and service to select Sunrise communities as appropriate. As communities begin welcoming new residents, we have established safeguards for the continued safety of our residents and team members. Specifically, any new resident is required to secure a COVID-19 test before they may move in and will have to self-quarantine in their suites for 14 days when they first arrive.

As always, we remain grateful to our residents and families for their continued patience, trust and partnership as we navigate these unprecedented times together.
